




## What is RCV?







## What is RCV?



Voters' first choices are counted. In this example, no candidate earned 50% of the vote.




Candidate C has the fewest votes and is eliminated.



Those ballots transfer to each voter's next choice candidate. Candidate A is elected.

## Where is RCV Used?

As of the 2022 elections, RCV has been adopted in 62 jurisdictions. Some prominent examples include:

- Alaska
- Burlington, VT
- Maine
- Minneapolis, MN
- New York City
- San Francisco, CA





# Sample RCV Ballots

#### INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS RANKED CHOICE VOTING

Use BLACK PEN to fill in the ovals. DO NOT USE PENCIL.

#### To vote:

- Completely fill in the oval in the 1st column for your 1st choice candidate.
- Optionally, fill in the oval in the 2nd column for your 2nd choice candidate.
- Continue to rank as many or as few of the candidates as you would like.
- To rank a write-in candidate, write the person's name in the write-in space and fill in the oval that corresponds with the ranking of your choice.
- Fill in no more than one oval per column.
- Fill in no more than one oval per candidate.
- Do not skip rankings. For example, do not fill in 1st and 3rd choices without filling in a 2nd choice.
- If you make a mistake, tear, or deface the ballot, return it to an election official and obtain another ballot. DO NOT ERASE.

Please ask any election official or poll worker if you need assistance.




