How does a family's contribution change as income relative to the Federal Poverty Level changes?

- Vermont's Child Care Financial Assistance Program (CCFAP) expects families with income above 150% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) to pay some or all Early Care and Education (ECE) tuition
- Families with income up to 150% of FPL now have no co-pay
 - Families with income just above 150% FPL up to 175% FPL pay \$25/week
 - Families with income just above 175% FPL up to 200% FPL pay \$50/week
 - And so on
- The CCFAP subsidy currently ends at 350% of FPL
- The CCFAP reimbursement rate for 5-star ECE center-based care in FY 2023 is capped at \$17,250 (an average of infant, toddler, and preschool amounts)



Child Care Financial Assistance State's Capped Rates Effective July 3, 2022

The State's capped rates are the maximum amount the State will pay to a child care provider on behalf of a family receiving child care financial assistance. The State will pay the lesser of the two: up to the provider's rate or the State's capped rate. To receive the maximum amount the State pays, a child care provider may need to increase their rates.
