

From our mapping expert, Johnathan Croft:

The answer is Yes, US-7 did go through downtown Vergennes, and was state aid town highway TH-1. There was a project between 1962 and 1964 that relocated US-7 to be in Ferrisburgh, and the segment that was US-7 became part of VT-22A and Ferrisburgh State Highway.
