Subject: Climate change; agriculture; taxation; tax on transit of agricultural
commodities

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to inform customers purchasing food of the carbon and climate change effects of the transit of agricultural commodities by establishing a tax on the mileage an agricultural commodity travels before retail sale in Vermont. "Agricultural commodity" would be defined to include horticultural crops, fruits, vegetables, poultry and meat processed for consumption, maple syrup, honey, milk, cheese, yogurt, and other dairy products. The tax would be assessed at \$0.001 per mile that an agricultural commodity travels from the location of original packing for shipment to the point where the commodity will be sold at retail. The bill would require the transporters of agricultural commodities to provide an invoice at delivery that includes the point of origin of shipment of each agricultural commodity delivered and the mileage travelled. The bill would deposit a third of the revenue from the tax in the General Fund, a third of the revenue in a special fund to raise awareness of carbon and climate change
