

1 TO THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

2 The Committee on Appropriations to which was referred House Bill No.
3 667 entitled “An act relating to the creation of the Vermont-Ireland Trade
4 Commission” respectfully reports that it has considered the same and
5 recommends that the report of the Committee on Government Operations and
6 Military Affairs be amended by striking out all after the enacting clause and
7 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8 Sec. 1. 9 V.S.A. chapter 111B is added to read:

9 CHAPTER 111B. TRADE COMMISSIONS

10 § 4129. VERMONT-IRELAND TRADE COMMISSION

11 (a) The Vermont-Ireland Trade Commission is established within the State
12 Treasurer’s office to advance bilateral trade and investment between Vermont
13 and Ireland. The Commission shall consist of 10 members as follows:

14 (1) three members, appointed by the Governor;

15 (2) three members, appointed by the Speaker of the House;

16 (3) three members, appointed by the Senate Committee on Committees;

17 and

18 (4) the State Treasurer or designee.

19 (b) The purposes of the Vermont-Ireland Trade Commission are to:

20 (1) advance bilateral trade and investment between Vermont and
21 Ireland;

1 (2) initiate joint action on policy issues of mutual interest to Vermont
2 and Ireland;

3 (3) promote business and academic exchanges between Vermont and
4 Ireland;

5 (4) encourage mutual economic support between Vermont and Ireland;

6 (5) encourage mutual investment in the infrastructure of Vermont and
7 Ireland; and

8 (6) address other issues as determined by the Commission.

9 (c) The members of the Commission, except for the State Treasurer or
10 designee, shall be appointed for terms of four years each and shall continue to
11 serve until their successors are appointed, except that in order to achieve
12 staggered terms, the three members appointed by the Governor shall serve
13 initial terms of two years each and the three members appointed by the Speaker
14 of the House shall serve initial terms of three years each. Members may be
15 reappointed. A member serves at the pleasure of the member's appointing
16 authority.

17 (d) A vacancy in the membership of the Commission shall be filled by the
18 relevant appointing authority within 90 days after the vacancy.

19 (e) The Commission shall select a chair from among its members at the
20 first meeting. The Chair, as appropriate, may appoint from among the
21 Commission members subcommittees or a subcommittee at the Chair's

1 discretion. A majority of the members of the Commission shall constitute a
2 quorum for purposes of transacting the business of the Commission.

3 (f) The Commission shall submit a written report with its findings, results,
4 and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly within one
5 year of its initial organizational meeting and on or before November 1 of each
6 succeeding year for the activities of the current calendar year.

7 (g) The Vermont-Ireland Trade Commission is authorized to raise funds,
8 through direct solicitation or other fundraising events, alone or with other
9 groups, and accept donations, grants, and bequests from individuals,
10 corporations, foundations, governmental agencies, and public and private
11 organizations and institutions, to defray the Commission’s administrative
12 expenses and to carry out its purposes as set forth in this chapter. The funds,
13 donations, grants, or bequests received pursuant to this chapter shall be
14 deposited in a bank account and allocated annually by the State Treasurer’s
15 office to defray the Commission’s administrative expenses and carry out its
16 purposes. Any monies so withdrawn shall not be used for any purpose other
17 than the payment of expenses under this chapter. Interest earned shall remain
18 in the bank account.

19 (h) Members of the Commission shall not receive compensation or be
20 entitled to reimbursement of expenses by the State of Vermont for their service
21 on the Commission.

1 Sec. 2. INITIAL APPOINTMENT DEADLINE FOR VERMONT-IRELAND
2 TRADE COMMISSION

3 Initial appointments to the Vermont-Ireland Trade Commission shall be
4 made not later than October 1, 2024.

5 Sec. 3. REPEAL; VERMONT-IRELAND TRADE COMMISSION

6 9 V.S.A. § 4129 (Vermont-Ireland Trade Commission) as added by this act
7 is repealed on June 30, 2029.

8 Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

9 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2024.
