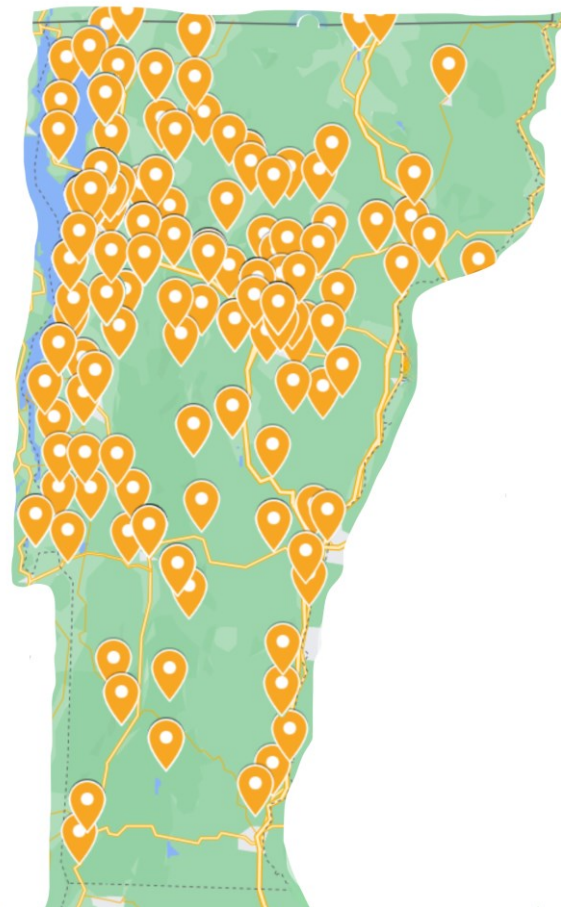

Service Project Map

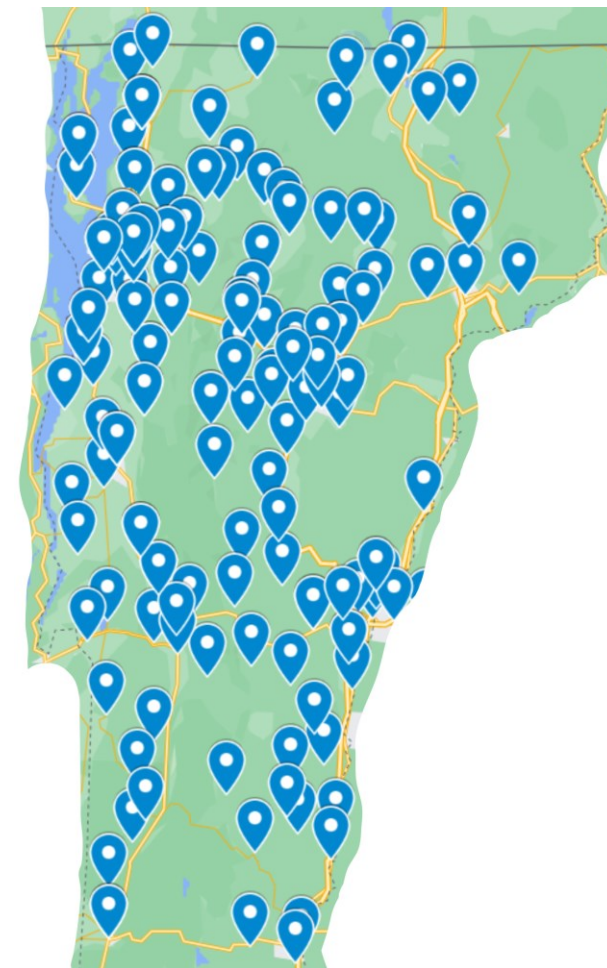
