

1 Sec. A. EDUCATION FINANCE INFORMATION; AGENCY OF
2 EDUCATION; REPORT

3 On or before September 15, 2024, the Agency of Education shall submit a
4 written report to the General Assembly that shall include the following
5 information for fiscal years 2023 and 2024:

6 (1) a financial analysis of the cost of the mental health services provided
7 by school districts and paid for from the Education Fund, broken down by
8 costs in the following categories:

9 (A) mental health staffing costs;

10 (B) mental health transportation related costs; and

11 (C) costs associated with educating students outside the district due
12 to mental health or behavioral needs;

13 (2) the districts that provide for the education of their students in any
14 grade by paying tuition, including the following information, by school
15 district:

16 (A) the number of students tuitioned in each grade; and

17 (B) the name and location of the schools students are tuitioned to,
18 including the number of students in each school district attending a particular
19 school and the amount of tuition charged by each receiving school; and

20 (3) an analysis of whether an inter agency collaboration between the
21 Agencies of Education and of Human Services to provide the social services

- 1 currently provided by school districts is possible and, if so, what the possible
- 2 advantages or disadvantages to such a collaboration may be.
