What is the cost today to obtain an OT license in Vermont? What documents are needed?

- \$115 for initial licensure (OTs and OT Assistants); \$180 every two years for renewal (OTs and OTAs)
- Documents needed (for application by examination – not eligible for any of our reciprocity pathways)
 - OTs
 - Transcripts from OT degree
 - Supervision documentation
 - Examination scores
 - If licensed previously in another state, verification of licensure from that state
 - If ever convicted of a crime, court documents related to the charges
 - If the license has been disciplined in another state, documents related to that discipline order
 - OTAs
 - Same as OTs but transcripts from OT associate degree

What is the cost today to obtain an OT license in New Hampshire? What documents are needed? Do they have a compact fee to join the OT compact?

- \$110 for OT and OTAs (initial and renewal)
