I. Background

In 2014, the State of Vermont passed legislation requiring all Vermont law enforcement agencies to collect and report (as amended in 2016) roadside traffic stop data to the Vermont Criminal Justice Council (VCJC), including the driver's age, gender, and race, the reason for the stop, type of search, evidence found, and the stop outcome. Soon after this legislation passed, analyses of these data were conducted by various researchers that raised concerns regarding the quality of data being collected, as well as possible racial disparities in traffic stops, arrests, and searches based on different statistical techniques used to conduct disparity assessments.

The National Policing Institute, formerly the National Police Foundation, was retained by the VCJC to compile, review, and analyze traffic stop data to identify challenges and opportunities for improvement in collection and analysis. This study aims to systematically assess and analyze traffic stop data provided to the VCJC from 2016 to 2020 to identify challenges and improvements to traffic stop data collection policies and processes.

The specific goals of this project are:

- Identifying opportunities to incorporate bias-free policing principles in traffic stops
- Producing a uniform traffic stop dataset for uploading or embedding to a public website
 that would facilitate future research efforts and the ability to produce visualizations and
 reports from the data collected
- Assessing the feasibility of using the combined dataset for testing for disproportionality
 at different stages of traffic stops, including the decision to stop, issue a citation, search,
 and arrest, using common disparity assessment techniques
- Developing recommendations to improve the efficiency and quality of traffic stop data collection, analysis, and reporting
- Developing recommendations for policies, procedures, practices, and training for conducting just and impartial traffic stops

The project team employed a mixed methods approach to understanding data collection processes and practices in Vermont, including the compilation and review of stop data provided by the VCJC. The project team performed a comprehensive data quality assessment and reviewed standard methods for analyzing traffic stop data with a feasibility assessment of applying each approach to Vermont stop data. Interviews and focus groups were also conducted with key stakeholders, providing valuable context for the recommendations.

Quantitative Data and Data Audit

The VCJC provided the project team with 95 distinct datasets purported to represent all traffic stops conducted by Vermont's law enforcement agencies from 2016-2020. This five-year period for submission included 710,998 records. A laborious multistage process was required to merge and clean these data due to the considerable inefficiencies in converting raw data files into an analysis-ready dataset. There were variations in the number of data fields included within the files and differences in the variable names, response options, and formats of data fields, requiring response values to be renamed or recoded for uniformity.

Once the 95 data files were merged into a single database, a detailed data audit process was implemented and combined with qualitative feedback and assessments from key stakeholders. Initial analyses demonstrated that the average percent of missing data statewide on one or more legislatively required variables was 16.9%, exceeding the recommended 10% or less threshold proposed by the Police Executive Research Forum for these data collection efforts.

During the final stages of the quantitative data audit conducted by senior project team members, several additional data quality issues were discovered that have delayed the final production of a reliable and valid statewide traffic stop database. A more detailed examination of the problems associated with duplicate records within the original raw data files demonstrated non-random errors associated with incident numbers used to identify individual stops. The inconsistencies identified within the incident numbers – including both missing and duplicate incident numbers – suggested that the associated stop data was unreliable for various reasons. The project team's attempted de-duplication process identified several scenarios resulting in two or more records with the same incident number. These include:

- 1. Stops of one individual with multiple outcomes
- 2. Stops of two (or more) individuals and outcomes listed for each
- 3. Records where the ticket number is used instead of an incident number for two records on the same day, hours apart
- 4. System or human error that attributes one incident number to multiple, different stops.

The simplest approach to correcting these data would be to remove any entry that does not have an identification number *or* a unique identification number. This crude approach, however, could potentially impact 19.1% of the traffic stops statewide and would result in the following:

- Under or overcounting traffic stops, statewide
- Concerns regarding the reliability and validity of any combined statewide dataset
- Impacts on future analyses of racial/ethnic disparities in traffic stops and stop outcomes

Therefore, the project team has compiled this supplemental report to facilitate the production of the statewide dataset. In Section 2, summary tables are provided to document the number of records received by each agency and the percentage of records with duplicate records or missing data issues. Section 3 lists the individual problems in each agency's data. The project team's next steps will be to work directly with the 61 affected agencies to understand better and document these issues to develop a plan to address them. This work will inform the final report and assumptions made by the project team to produce a statewide stop database. This will ensure transparency throughout the process, allowing future analyses of this dataset to be appropriately qualified.

The timeline for this process is as follows:

- Supplemental report with an agency-by-agency description of data issues requiring further discussion: 1/16/2023
- Meetings with agencies to discuss the supplemental report: 1/17/2023 2/4/2023
- Final report and delivery of unified dataset: 2/28/2023

II. Agency-Specific Data (2016 – 2020)

This section provides a series of tables to summarize the data quality issues identified for all law enforcement agencies in Vermont. It is important to note that the purpose of this report, as well as the agency-specific consultations that will follow, is to provide feedback to ensure agencies have a better understanding of the state of their data. This will help inform improvements in policies and practices within and across agencies and assist the project team in producing a more reliable statewide traffic stop database.

Table 1 displays the total number of records submitted by each agency, the percent of records missing an incident ID, the percent of duplicate records due to overlapping source data files, and the percent of duplicate records due to other reasons. The date ranges vary by agency; some agencies provided data from 2016 through 2020, while others were unavailable for one or more years.

Of the 710,998³ statewide records, 11.5% did not have unique incident identifying numbers (n=81,717).⁴ This percentage varied widely across agencies. This is important because the project team's data audit process included an effort to remove duplicate cases, but this deduplication process was dependent upon the availability of incident numbers. For cases without a valid incident number, the team could not systematically identify or remove duplicate records of the same stop. Under these circumstances, Autilio and colleagues (2020) recommended using the agency identifier, stop date and time, and driver age, gender, and race to identify duplicates. Unfortunately, there is inconsistency across agencies in handling stops with multiple outcomes, and many agencies train officers to omit data for additional rows when multiple outcomes are recorded. In these circumstances, the team would be unable to identify duplicates systematically. The project team will follow up with 37 agencies with at least 100 records and 10% of the records have missing incident identifying numbers (see Section 3).

Overall, the project team identified 53,703 records (7.6%) that shared incident numbers with at least one other record. A straightforward explanation and resolution were available in approximately two-thirds of the duplicate records (n=36,588). In these cases, the same stop records were submitted to the VCJC in more than one original data file. For example, an agency's data could have been submitted in a 2018 Valcour or Spillman RMS data file, and the agency also submitted its own data file for the same year. In this situation, where all variables are the same except for the source data file variable, the duplicate record can be removed with

¹ Agency identifying information was missing in the original data files for 273 stops. The agency name could not be inferred from the file name because multiple agencies were included in the dataset. These 273 stops are excluded from this table.

² It is unknown why this is the case. It is possible some agencies did not collect data, did not submit collected data, or did not conduct a traffic stop during the time period.

³ This includes a small percentage (<2%) of externally generated stops, which will be removed from the unified state dataset when it is created as it is only appropriate to examine discretionary stops when exploring whether racial disparities exist. One outlier in this regard is the stops submitted by the VT Department of Motor Vehicles, more than half of which resulted from roadside inspections. The project team will work with the DMV to systematically distinguish inspections-related and externally generated stops from discretionary stops (see Section 3).

⁴ For incidents missing an ID number (n=46,589) or that had N/A as an ID number (n=35,128) the team generated its own incident identifier for internal use.

confidence that no loss of information has occurred. Therefore, no follow-up with individual agencies is necessary to correct this issue to produce the statewide dataset.

Unfortunately, the remaining 17,115 duplicate records (2.4% of all records) are not so easily resolved. In these circumstances, records with identical incident numbers contain inconsistencies or missing data, making it challenging to identify which records should be retained or removed. The prevalence of these duplicate records varied widely by agency, as demonstrated in Table 1 (agencies with duplicate records highlighted in red). The project team will follow up with 38 agencies with at least 100 records that have *any* instances of duplicate incident numbers (see Section 3).

⁵ The state of Vermont did not provide the Institute with any datasets from the following agencies: Mount Tabor Police Department, Rutland Constabulary, VT Department of Corrections, VT Department of Public Safety, VT Homeland Security Unit, VT States Attorneys' & Sheriffs' Office, VT Secretary of State's Office of Professional Regulation, VT Board of Medical Practice, Chittenden Unit for Special Investigations, Northwest Unit for Special Investigations. In addition, the Town of Mendon Constable did not provide a dataset but rather a summary report of 76 traffic stops that could not be included. Middlebury Police Department provided information regarding 1,095 stops conducted from September 1, 2016, to August 31, 2017, in a PDF file that the Institute deemed too laborintensive to manually convert to electronic data. Finally, Randolph Police Department and Waterbury Village Police Department have since contracted out policing services to Orange County Sheriff's Department and VSP, respectively. We include them in these descriptions as part of the overall data audit for 2016 – 2020 data.

In a best practice guide for traffic stop data collection published by the Police Executive Research Forum (PERF) in 2004, Fridell identified 10% as a target for agencies to stay under when reviewing data for missingness; if there is a much higher prevalence of missing data, it may be necessary to adjust training or oversight to ensure the root of the issue is identified. Table 2 displays, statewide and by agency, the overall percent of missing data from 2016-2020 and the percent of missing data by individual year. ⁶ These percentages are based on a composite variable created by the project team that represents the percentage of records with missing data on one or more of the legislatively required variables. ⁷ It is also important to note that agencies with a value of 100% in the table for any given year are not missing 100% of the data; rather, 100% of the records they submitted have missing data on at least one of the required variables. The specific variables with missing data are documented next in Table 3.

As shown in Table 2, the percentage of agencies' records with legislatively required missing data varies widely. Rates that exceed 10% are highlighted in red in Table 2. For some agencies, the percentages should be interpreted with caution based on a small number of total stops. A total of 51 agencies exceeded the 10% missing data threshold overall from 2016 to 2020. The project team will follow up with 29 agencies with at least 100 records that exceed the 10% missing data threshold overall and are not showing improvement in 2019 and 2020. An additional eight agencies demonstrating progress on missing data are being followed up with for other data quality issues. Since they are already being contacted, the project team will also inquire about missing data.

⁶ It is important to note that the percentage of missing data reported in Figure 1 may be slightly inflated based on the inclusion of duplicate records.

⁷ This percentage reflects the records where there was no information provided in the original source data files for age, race, gender, stop reason, stop outcome, search, or contraband. It also includes instances where 'NA' was entered for search (n=1,625) or contraband (n=2,533). It does not assess invalid data entries (e.g., where information was entered that does not match given response options for that field or where, for example, a zero was entered for age). It also does not reflect the percent of records where "unknown" race or gender was entered.

Table 3 displays the percentage of missing data on the seven legislatively required data fields for all law enforcement agencies for which the Institute received data. Statewide, the variables with the highest percent of missing data were age, search, and contraband, but the rate of missing data varied widely across agencies and variables. Again, for some agencies, the percentages should be interpreted with caution based on a small number of total stops.

The Institute inquired in several interviews about possible reasons for large percentages of missing data. In some cases, agency representatives indicated that the data files held by the individual law enforcement agencies were more complete than the data received by the VCJC. The Institute did not initially verify these statements, and there was no explanation for the cause of this information loss. However, in some records, missing data could indicate a need for further communication and training for the officers (Fridell, 2004). Ideally, individual variables should have less than 5% missing data. As noted above, the project team intends to follow up with 29 agencies with larger volumes of missing data that have yet to improve over time to ascertain the root of this problem and identify potential resolutions for correcting this issue moving forward.

III. Agency Data Challenges

The project team received 95 datasets from Vermont law enforcement agencies containing traffic stop data for 2016 – 2020. In this section, the 61 agencies identified for follow-up are listed along with the names of the source data files in which their data was found. Additionally, the agencies' total records across datasets and the number of records received without an incident number are listed. These agencies require more targeted follow-up discussions for the project team to understand better the causes of duplicate records, high volumes of missing data, or high volumes of records without incident numbers. The project team developed assumptions for interpreting each scenario, but confirmation of these assumptions is necessary to move forward. Agencies' data will not be reviewed at the individual case level. Instead, examples of specific data challenges will be reviewed, and these resolutions will be applied to the overall data. As a result, the uniform dataset may still contain errors, but the project team anticipates that the impact of these errors will be minimal.

The project team will conduct one-on-one meetings with each agency to confirm or revise the assumptions made. Through these conversations, the project team intends to understand how to handle these records on an aggregate level. The project team will seek to understand policies, training practices, or data collection methods that may have led to the following issues. It is important to reiterate that the purpose of this supplemental report and the follow-up communications is to glean information that can assist in establishing a feedback loop for these agencies to improve data collection efforts in the future and to assist the project team in producing a more reliable statewide traffic stop database.
