My name is [REDACTED]. I have COPD and cannot be stuck outside because of the condition of my lungs since this program has started I've been able to get my health stable and if this program ends I don't know how my health and well being will hold up if the housing ends. Please fully fund this program to keep all homeless Vermonters housed

Hello my name is [REDACTED] I am writing because I am in the hotel program at the Hollow Inn. I am on SSI disability. I live with my 20 yr old daughter and her 2 children who are also on the hotel program. If you end this program we will be on the streets and the children taken away. No matter what your status is all people deserve shelter.

Hi my name is [REDACTED] im writing to you because i would like you to fund the GA Program because when the program ends i will have nowhere to live. I will be out on the streets in the cold with a child. I won't be able to shower, eat hot meals, sleep in a bed . I am not alone, I'm a single mom of 3 young kids [REDACTED] 12 [REDACTED] 9 [REDACTED] 5, and I am 4 months pregnant. If the motel programs are to stop my children and I will be homeless. I do not have any where to go. I do not have very many options. We do not have family to live with or even friends. My old apartment was to much to afford. This is why we are staying at [REDACTED]. I did work part time and I am disabled. I look everyday for a job that my body can handle doing, it's not easy but I am trying. I been looking for apartments that I can afford alone and it seems so hard. I filled out applications for subsidy housing and section 8. I'm in fear every day of becoming homeless living in a tent somewhere with my children and definitely with a new born baby. I did not ask to be living like this. I really miss living in a apartment, A home with my children! Living at hotel is not idea but it definitely beats living in a tent with no water no electricity no beds. A hotel at least makes me comfortable and makes me feel at ease knowing that my babies have working water and a roof to keep them warm and away from anything that could harm them. We need the help. Especially for my children and for the new born baby. We deserve to have a place a roof over us and to feel safe enough to close our eyes at night. We did not ask for this but it has happened and I truly feel like it is your duty to help all Vermonts deserve shelter especially in a crisis like this.
