

# Brief Overview: State Education Standards

# How is state education policy developed in Vermont?

- General Assembly---passes statute/law
- State Board of Education (SBE)---develops, vets, and enacts rules based on statute
- State Agency of Education (AOE)---develops guidance, technical assistance, best practice examples, and professional learning materials to assist school districts
- Local Education Agencies (LEAs)---develop local policy and practice addressing how they will meet the statute and rules
  - LEAs usually school district or SU

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  - **EXAMPLE: Universal PreK (Act 166)**
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  - **EXAMPLE: Rule Series 2600, Prekindergarten education**

- Local Education Agencies (LEAs)---develop local policy and practice addressing how they will meet the statute and rules
  - **Varies by LEA**

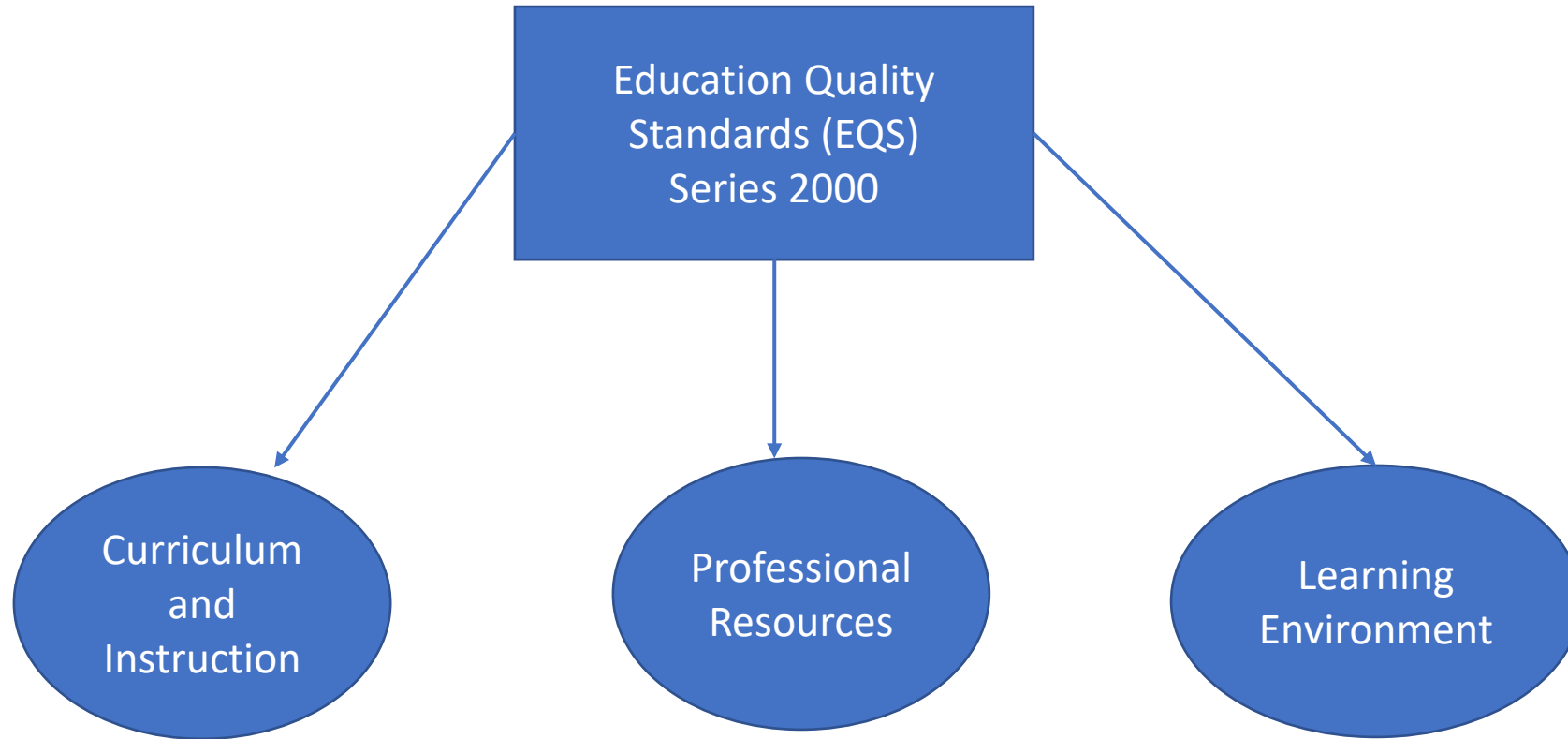
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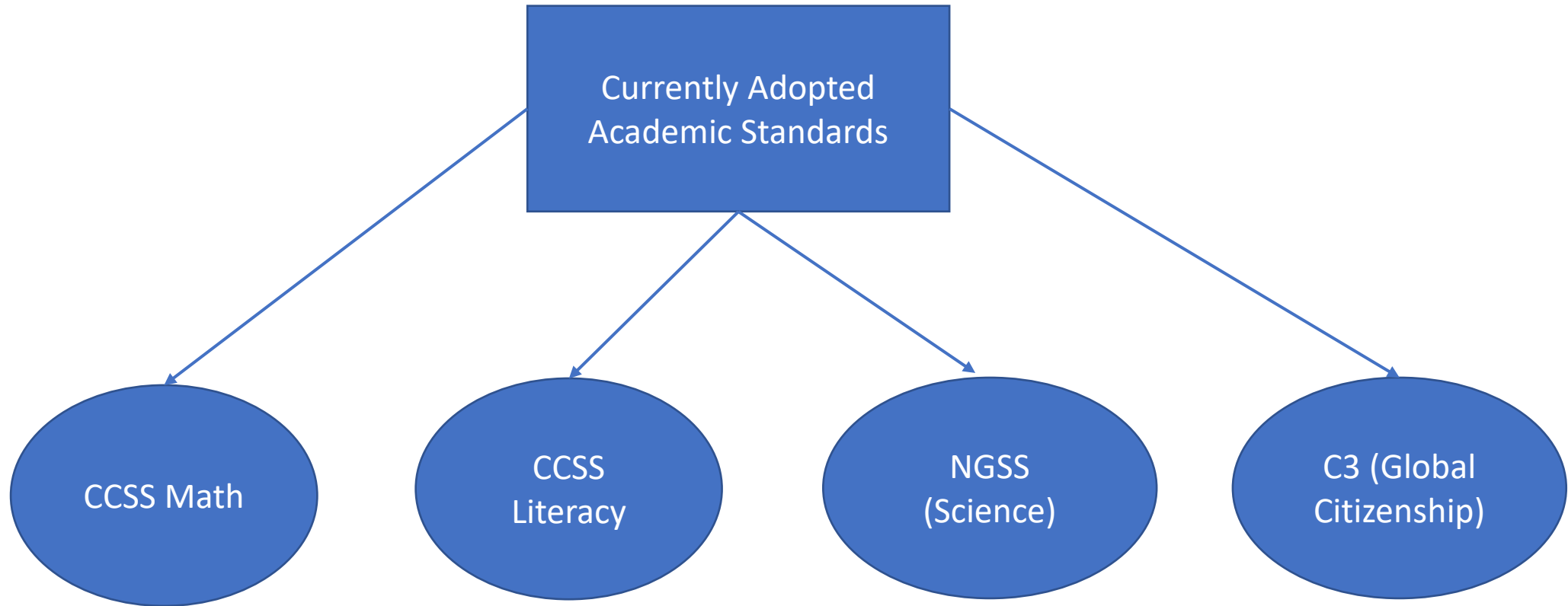
