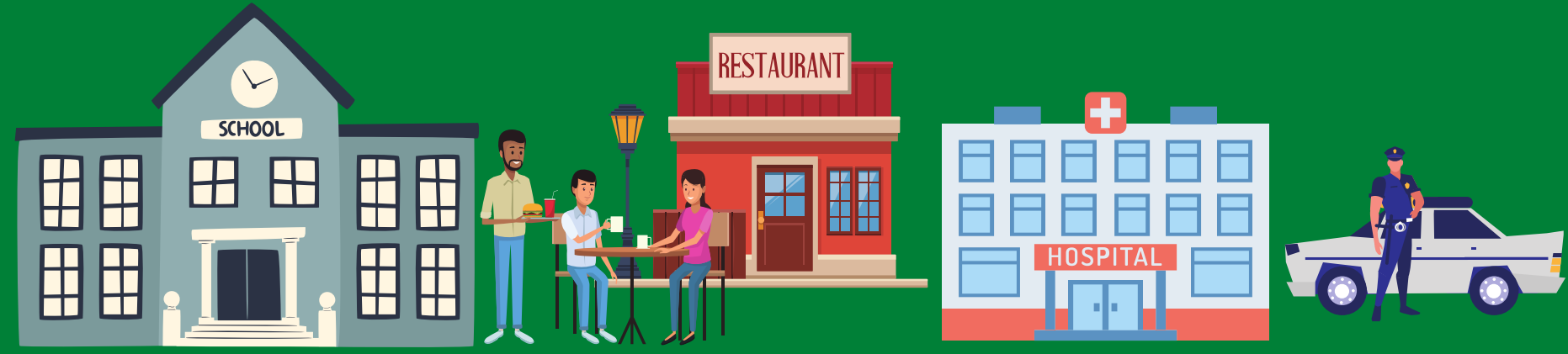
Vermont Human Rights Commission enforces the following anti-discrimination laws in the state
