### **Governing Statutes**

#### 30 V.S.A. § 7523

Beginning on July 1, 2019, the rate of charge established under subsection (a) of this section shall be increased by four-tenths of one percent of retail telecommunications service, and the monies collected from this increase shall be transferred to the Vermont Community Broadband Fund established under section 8083 of this title....

#### 30 V.S.A. § 7511

Governs the order of priority for distribution of revenue. If insufficient revenue exist, the order of priority must be followed
