2 Senator Ingalls moves that the report of the Committee on Government

5 First: By striking out Secs. 2–4 in their entirety and inserting in lieu thereof

8 § 1051. SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE AND PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE

9 OF THE SENATE; COMPENSATION AND EXPENSE

10 REIMBURSEMENT

11 ~~(a)~~ The Speaker of the House and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate
12 shall be entitled to receive annual compensation of \$10,080.00 for the 2005
13 Biennial Session and thereafter, to be paid in biweekly payments, provided
14 that, beginning on January 1, 2007, the annual compensation shall be adjusted
15 annually thereafter by the cost of living adjustment negotiated for State
16 employees under the most recent collective bargaining agreement, except that,
17 beginning on July 1, 2021 and annually thereafter on January 1, the annual
18 compensation shall be adjusted consistent with the compensation increases
19 provided to other constitutional officers. In addition to the annual
20 compensation, the Speaker and President Pro Tempore shall be entitled to
21 receive:

1 adjusted consistent with the compensation increases provided to other
2 constitutional officers. The salary of members shall be paid in biweekly
3 installments.

6 Second: By striking out Sec. 8, effective dates, in its entirety and inserting
7 in lieu thereof a new Sec. 8 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 8. EFFECTIVE DATES

9 (a) Secs. 5 (legislative leave from employment) and 6 (Legislative Service
10 Working Group) and this section shall take effect on passage.

11 (b) Sec. 7 (appropriation) shall take effect on July 1, 2023.

12 (c) Sec. 1 (health benefits) shall take effect on January 1, 2024.

13 (d) The remaining sections shall take effect on January 1, 2025.
