<a href="#">Community Supervision Population</a>	Point-in-time analyses of the population supervised in the community including crime, demographic, and supervision location.	Monthly
<a href="#">Facility Total Population Over Time</a>	Longitudinal line graph of the total VT DOC incarcerated population since 03/13/2020.	Daily
<a href="#">Gender Report</a>	The Gender report provides more detailed information from the Population Characteristics, Violent Crime, and Minimum Release reports, which are all available within the Reports and Data section of the website.	Quarterly

<a href="#">Segregation Report</a>	Longitudinal analyses reporting on restrictive housing (segregation) for all incarcerated individuals placed in segregation.	Quarterly
<a href="#">SFI Designation Report</a>	Point-in-time report that examines the SFI-Designated population in relation to the general incarcerated population across a variety of metrics.	Quarterly
<a href="#">Point-in-Time MAT Report</a>	Point-in-time report that examines the population receiving MAT in relation to the general incarcerated population across a variety of metrics.	Quarterly
<a href="#">Longitudinal MAT Report</a>	Longitudinal report that examines the incarcerated population receiving MAT since September 1, 2018 after Act 176 was fully implemented in Vermont in-state correctional facilities.	Quarterly
<a href="#">Releases from Incarceration (Longitudinal)</a>	Longitudinal calendar year analyses of incarcerated individuals who were released from Vermont correctional facilities.	Monthly
<a href="#">Minimum Release Report</a>	Point-in-time analyses regarding minimum release information for incarcerated individuals, including data for those held past minimum release.	Quarterly
<a href="#">Recidivism Calculation</a>	<p>Citation- 2011 Act 41 Section 5: "The Department shall calculate the rate of recidivism based upon offenders who are sentenced to more than one year of incarceration who, after release from incarceration, return to prison within three years for a conviction for a new offense or a violation of supervision resulting, and the new incarceration sentence or time served on the violation is at least 90 days."</p> <p>The definition of a prison sentence is sentenced to serve (maximum) more than one year (US Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Statistics). Thus, recidivism does NOT include the incarcerated individuals released each year with a shorter "jail" sentence of one year or less.</p> <p>Note: Due to the definition of recidivism provided in the above citation, the most up-to-date recidivism calculation is for 3 years prior to the current calendar year.</p>	Annual
<a href="#">Budget Performance Measures</a>	As part of the annual budget report, the DOC provides performance measures for programs and services provided by the DOC. These programs and services include Correctional Services (incarcerated, community supervision, parole board), Health Services (mental and physical health, MAT), Program and Services (education, VT Correctional Industries, Behavior and Life Skill Interventions, transitional housing), Office of Professional Standards and Compliance (Academy, professional development, constituency services, Prison and Rape Elimination Act, Special Teams). This information is updated each winter with data for the previous fiscal year (July 1 - June 30).	Annual
