

Automated Work Zone Speed Control Violation Notice

You are the registered owner of a vehicle that is alleged to have traveled in excess of 15 miles per hour greater than the posted speed limit in a highway work zone. This alleged violation was recorded by a speed detection camera. This action violates Connecticut General Statutes Sections 13a-262 through 13a-268. Records show that this is your second or subsequent violation captured by speed detection camera. Therefore, you are subject to the monetary penalty shown on the attached Complaint Ticket. This Notice is issued in accordance with Connecticut General Statute Section 13a-264. This amount is due by the Answer Date on this Notice and Complaint Ticket.

You may pay by doing the following: a. Sign below (in this section) and mail this complaint ticket with the Amount Due to the Centralized Infractions Bureau before the "Answer Date" shown on this ticket. Use the pre-addressed envelope you were given with this ticket. b. Have a money order or check made payable to "Clerk of the Superior Court". Do not mail cash. Write the complaint ticket number on your check or money order. Partial payment will not be accepted. c. If you are charged with a motor vehicle infraction or violation and you choose to pay the amount due to the Centralized Infractions Bureau, no points will be assessed against your operator's license by the Connecticut Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, except that the Commissioner shall assess at least one point against your operator's license for any violation of section 14-296aa of the Connecticut General Statutes for the improper use of a hand-held mobile telephone or mobile electronic device by a motor vehicle operator or school bus driver. Also note that your payment may result in administrative sanctions being imposed on you by the Commissioner, including license suspension. <i>I waive (give up) my right to a trial and enter a plea of Nolo Contendere (no contest) to all charges on this complaint ticket.</i> Personal Signature (If minor, parent or guardian must also sign)	<input type="checkbox"/> I choose to plead not guilty by mail Sign below and mail this complaint ticket to the Centralized Infractions Bureau before the "Answer Date" shown. 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If you do not pay or send in a plea, you may be arrested and your motor vehicle license may be suspended. If your motor vehicle license is suspended for not following the instructions (example: sending a bad check), reinstatement of your license will require: a) paying to the court a substantial additional fee for filing a motion to set aside the license suspension, b) paying a fine which could be more than the amount shown and c) paying an additional fee to the Motor Vehicle Department to have your license reinstated.
