4	(a) Definition. As used in this section, "hands-free use" means the use of a			
5	portable electronic device without use of either hand and outside the immediate			
6	proximity of the user's ear, by employing an internal feature of, or an			
7	attachment to, the device.			
8	(b) Use of handheld portable electronic device in work zone prohibited. A			
9	person shall not use a portable electronic device while operating a moving			
10	motor vehicle within a highway work zone while construction, maintenance, or			
11	utility work is actively under way. This prohibition shall not apply to
