11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1095b is amended to read:
13	\S 1095b. HANDHELD USE OF PORTABLE ELECTRONIC DEVICE IN
14	WORK ZONE PROHIBITED
15	(a) Definition. As used in this section, "hands-free use" means the use of a
16	portable electronic device without use of either hand and outside the immediate
17	proximity of the user's ear, by employing an internal feature of, or an
18	attachment to, the device.
19	(b) Use of handheld portable electronic device in work zone prohibited. A

person shall not use a portable electronic device while operating a moving

motor vehicle within on a highway work zone in this State. The prohibition of
this subsection shall not apply unless the work zone is properly designated
with warning devices in accordance with subdivision 4(5) of this title, and shall
not apply:
(1) to hands-free use;
(2) to use of a global positioning or navigation system; or
(2)(3) when use of a portable electronic device is necessary to
communicate with law enforcement or emergency service personnel under
emergency circumstances.
(c) Penalty. A person who violates this section commits a traffic violation
and shall be subject to a penalty of not less than \$100.00 and not more than
\$200.00 upon adjudication of for a first violation, and of not less than \$250.00
and not more than \$500.00 upon adjudication of for a second or subsequent
violation within any two-year period.
(d) Penalties for same conduct. A person shall not be issued more than one
complaint for violations of this section, section 1095a of this title (junior
operator use of portable electronic devices), and section 1099 of this title
(texting prohibited), or a combination of these, that arise from the
same conduct.
