- 3 (a) A person who serves without compensation as a director, officer,
- 4 trustee, employee, or volunteer for a homeless shelter shall not be subject to
- 5 <u>civil liability resulting from:</u>
- 6 (1) any act or omission within the scope of the person's official
- 7 <u>functions or duties which is done in good faith;</u>
- 8 (2) any good faith act or omission of any of the homeless shelter's other
- 9 <u>directors, officers, trustees, employees, or volunteers.</u>
- 10 (b) This section shall not apply to gross negligence, recklessness, or
- 11 intentional misconduct on the part of the director, officer, trustee, employee, or
- 12 <u>volunteer.</u>
- 13 (c) As used in this section:
- 14 (1) "Homeless person" means a person who lacks housing (without
- 15 regard to whether the person is a member of a family), including a person
