11	Subject: Elections; registration of voters; election day registration
12	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend voter
13	registration laws to allow a person to register to vote through the day of an
14	election.
15	An act relating to election day registration
16	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
17	Sec. 1. 17 V.S.A. § 2142 is amended to read:
18	§ 2142. REVISION OF CHECKLIST
19	(a) The town clerk shall call such meetings of the board of civil authority as
20	may be necessary before an election or at other times for revision of the

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1	checklist. At least one meeting shall take place after the deadline for filing
2	applications and before the day of an election, unless no applications have been
3	filed which could take effect before that election.
4	(b) Notice of a meeting, along with a copy of the most recent checklist and
5	a separate list of names which have been challenged and may be removed,
6	shall be posted in two or more public places within each voting district and in
7	the town clerk's office.
8	(c) A quorum of the board of civil authority shall be as provided in
9	subdivision 2103(5) of this title, and written notice shall be provided to each
10	member as established in 24 V.S.A. § 801.

12	§ 2144. DEADLINE FOR <u>SUBMITTING</u> APPLICATIONS
13	(a) The town clerk shall not accept applications for persons' names to be
14	placed on the checklist after 5:00 p.m. on the Wednesday preceding the day of
15	the election. The town clerk's office shall be kept open on the Wednesday
16	preceding the day of the election from no later than 3:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m.,
17	for the purpose of receiving applications for addition to the checklist. For
18	purposes of this subsection, a mail application or an application submitted to
19	the department of motor vehicles in connection with a motor vehicle driver's

license or an application accepted by a voter registration agency shall be

considered to have met the filing deadline established by this subsection if the

1	application is postmarked, submitted, or accepted by 5:00 p.m. of the
2	Wednesday preceding the day of the election On any day other than the day of
3	an election, the town clerk shall accept a person's application for his or her
4	name to be placed on the checklist at the town clerk's office during all normal
5	<u>business hours</u> .
6	(b) If a person is not eligible to register prior to the voter registration
7	deadline, but expects to be eligible on or before election day, he or she may file
8	with the town clerk a written notice of intention to apply for addition of his or
9	her name to the checklist. The notice shall be filed prior to the voter
10	registration deadline, and the town clerk shall then accept the person's
11	application at any time before the close of the polls on election day, and act
12	upon the application forthwith On the day of an election:
13	(1) A person may submit an application for addition to the checklist to
14	the presiding officer at the polling place of the town in which the person seeks
15	to register during the hours of voting established by the board of civil authority
16	for that polling place. In towns with more than one polling place, the polling
17	place shall be that which covers the area in which the person resides.
18	(2) The presiding officer shall review all applications submitted at the
19	polling place and shall approve those applications that meet the requirements
20	of this chapter. Upon approval, the applicant shall be added to the checklist at

the polling place and provided with the opportunity to vote in the election. The

1	town clerk shall add the information in the application to the statewide voter
2	checklist within three days of the day of the election.
3	(3) If the presiding officer cannot determine from an application
4	submitted on election day that an applicant meets the requirements of section
5	2121 of this chapter, the presiding officer shall immediately refer the
6	application to any members of the board of civil authority present at the polling
7	place, who shall meet immediately and proceed under section 2146 of this
8	chapter to determine whether the applicant meets the requirements of section
9	2121 of this chapter. For purposes of adding applicants to the checklist under
10	this subdivision (3), a quorum shall consist of three members of the board of
11	civil authority.
12	(c) If a person is not eligible to register prior to the voter registration
13	deadline, and has submitted a written notice of intent to apply in accord with
14	subsection (b) of this section, the clerk shall, upon application, allow the
15	applicant to vote absentee. If the application is approved and the name added
16	to the checklist prior to the close of the polls on election day, the early or
17	absentee ballots cast by that voter shall be treated as other valid early or
18	absentee ballots.
19	(d) In the case of annual meetings and towns that start their annual
20	meetings on any day preceding the first Tuesday in March as authorized in

1	subsection 2640(b) of this title, the "day of election" shall be the first Tuesday
2	in March.

10	agency.
11	(3) By delivering, during regular hours, or mailing a completed
12	application form to the office of the clerk of the town in which the applicant
13	claims to be a resident.

16	which the person seeks to register. In towns with more than one polling place,

4	(a) An application for, or renewal of, a motor vehicle driver's license shall
5	serve as a simultaneous application to register to vote unless the applicant
6	declines to sign the voter registration portion of the application.
7	(b) The voter registration portion of the motor vehicle driver's license
8	application shall provide and request the information required to be provided
9	under section 2145 of this title chapter and shall be in the form approved by the
10	Secretary of State.
11	(c) An application for voter registration under this section shall update any
12	previous voter registration by the applicant. Any change of address form
13	submitted to the Department of Motor Vehicles in connection with an
14	application for a motor vehicle driver's license shall serve to update voter
