3	(a) The Vermont Traumatic Brain Injury Fund is established in the Office
4	of the State Treasurer as a special fund to be a source of financing for services
5	for individuals with TBI and for programs established by or through contracts
6	with the Agency of Human Services for the treatment of traumatic brain
7	injuries.
8	(b) Into the Fund shall be deposited \$1.00 from each annual registration fee
9	and \$2.00 from each biennial registration fee collected under 23 V.S.A. § 361,
10	proceeds from grants, donations, contributions, taxes, and any other sources of
