9	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
10	Sec. 1. 18 V.S.A. § 1742(a) is amended to read:
11	(a) The possession of lighted tobacco products in any form is prohibited in:
12	(1) the common areas of all enclosed indoor places of public access and
13	publicly owned buildings and offices;
14	(2) any area within 25 feet of the windows, doors, ventilation systems,
15	or other openings of places of public access;
16	(3) all enclosed indoor places in lodging establishments used for
17	transient traveling or public vacationing, such as resorts, hotels, and motels,
18	including sleeping quarters and adjoining rooms rented to guests;
19	(3)(4) designated smoke-free areas of property or grounds owned by or
20	leased to the State; and

1	(4)(5) any other area within 25 feet of State-owned buildings and
2	offices, except that to the extent that any portion of the 25-foot zone is not on
3	State property, smoking is prohibited only in that portion of the zone that is on
4	State property unless the owner of the adjoining property chooses to designate
5	his or her property smoke-free.
