14	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
15	Sec. 1. VERMONT FALSE CLAIMS ACT

1	Sec. 2. INCENTIVE PROGRAM
2	(a) The Executive Branch shall establish a program to provide incentives
3	for persons to report waste and fraud in State resources, monies, contracts, and
4	programs.
5	(b) The Executive Branch shall:
6	(1) Establish a website and 24-hour hotline to allow the reporting of
7	waste and fraud involving State resources, monies, contracts, and programs.
8	The website and hotline shall allow a person to report anonymously or to
9	provide his or her name, address, and contact information.
10	(2) Ensure that any person who files a report pursuant to subdivision (1)
11	of this subsection and provides his or her name, address, and contact
12	information shall receive an award equivalent to ten percent of any saving of
13	State monies that results from that person's report, which savings are greater
14	than \$1,000.00.
15	Sec. 3. LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
16	On or before December 15, 2015, the Office of Legislative Council shall
17	provide to the House and Senate Committees on Judiciary and on Government
18	Operations proposed statutory amendments necessary to accomplish the
19	purpose of Sec. 2 of this act.
20	Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE
21	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
