13	(a) Creation. There is created a Clean Water Fund Board which shall
14	recommend to the Secretary of Administration expenditures from the Clean
15	Water Fund. The Clean Water Fund Board shall be attached to the Agency of
16	Administration for administrative purposes.
17	(b) Organization of the Board. The Clean Water Fund Board shall be
18	composed of:
19	(1) the <u>The</u> Secretary of Administration or designee;.
20	(2) the <u>The</u> Secretary of Natural Resources or designee;.

1	(3) the <u>The</u> Secretary of Agriculture, Food and Markets or designee;.
2	(4) the <u>The</u> Secretary of Commerce and Community Development or
3	designee <del>; and</del> .
4	(5) the <u>The</u> Secretary of Transportation or designee.
5	(6) Three members of the public or the House of Representatives
6	appointed by the Speaker of the House, each of whom shall be from a separate
7	major watershed of the State. At least one of the members appointed under
8	this subdivision shall be a municipal official.
9	(7) Three members of the public or the Senate appointed by the
10	Committee on Committees, each of whom shall be from a separate major
11	watershed of the State. At least one of the members appointed under this
12	subdivision shall be a municipal official.
13	(c) Officers; committees; rules; reimbursement.
14	(1) The Clean Water Fund Board shall annually elect a chair from its
15	members. The Clean Water Fund Board may elect additional officers from its
16	members, establish committees or subcommittees, and adopt procedural rules
17	as necessary and appropriate to perform its work.
18	(2) Members of the Board who are not employees of the State of
19	Vermont and who are not otherwise compensated or reimbursed for their
20	attendance shall be entitled to per diem compensation and reimbursement of
