12	(a) As used in this section, "tobacco products" shall have the same meaning
13	as in 7 V.S.A. § 1001.
14	(b) The possession of lighted tobacco products in any form is prohibited
15	anywhere on the property of condominiums and other multi-unit housing,
16	including rented dwelling units, individual living units, interior common areas,
17	interior exclusive use areas, and within 50 feet of these locations.
18	(c) A condominium association, or the owner or owner's agent of a
19	multi-unit dwelling other than a condominium, may designate for residents one
20	or more outdoor areas for smoking, which may be partially enclosed, that

- comply with the requirements of subsection (b) of this section and do not
- 2 permit smoke to drift into rented dwelling units, individual living units, interior
- 3 common areas, or interior exclusive use areas.

- 5 This act shall take effect on January 1, 2017.
