Subject: Appropriations; revenues; Universal Basic Income

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to create a
Universal Basic Income Commission to study and analyze the adoption of
Universal Basic Income in Vermont.

An act relating to a Universal Basic Income study

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. UNIVERSAL BASIC INCOME; COMMISSION; STUDY

(a) There is created a Universal Basic Income Commission to make
recommendations on, and provide a long-term vision for, Universal Basic
Income in Vermont. The Commission shall consist of three members, with one
appointed by the Governor, one appointed by the Speaker of the House, and
one appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

(b) The Commission shall study and prepare an analysis of Universal Basic
Income in Vermont, including potential revenue sources and the amount of
funding needed.

1 (c) On or before December 15, 2016, the Commission shall submit a report
2 to the General Assembly on the study described in subsection (b) of this
3 section.

4 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

5 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
