12	(a) There is created a Universal Basic Income Commission to make
13	recommendations on, and provide a long-term vision for, Universal Basic
14	Income in Vermont. The Committee shall consist of three members, with one
15	appointed by the Governor, one appointed by the Speaker of the House, and
16	one appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.
17	(b) The Commission shall study and prepare an analysis of Universal Basic
18	Income in Vermont, including potential revenue sources and the amount of
19	funding needed.

1	(c) On or before December 15, 2016, the Commission shall submit a report
2	to the General Assembly on the study described in subsection (b) of this
3	section.
