7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to permit, on or
8	before July 1, 2019, a school district to withdraw from a union school district

11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. TEMPORARY AUTHORITY TO WITHDRAW FROM UNION
13	SCHOOL DISTRICT
14	(a) Notwithstanding 16 V.S.A. § 721a, a school district which is a member
15	of a union school district on July 1, 2019 may withdraw from the union school
16	district without approval by the remaining members of the school district upon
17	the following conditions:
18	(1) At least one year has elapsed since the union school district became
19	a body politic and corporate as provided in 16 V.S.A. § 706g.

(2) On or before July 1, 2019, a majority of the voters of a school	
district that is a member of a union school district present and voting at a	
school district meeting duly warned for that purpose votes to withdraw from	
the union school district. The vote shall be certified by the clerk of the school	<u> 1</u>
district to the Secretary of State, who shall record the certificate in his or her	
office and shall give notice of the vote to the Secretary of Education and to the	he
other members of the union school district.	
(3) The State Board approves the withdrawal based on a	
recommendation from the Secretary of Education.	
(b) In making its recommendation, the Secretary of Education shall asses	S
whether students in the withdrawing district would attend a school that is in	
compliance with the rules adopted by the State Board pertaining to education	ıal

whether students in the withdrawing district would attend a school that is in compliance with the rules adopted by the State Board pertaining to educational programs, and whether it is in the best interests of the State, the students, and the districts remaining in the union district for the union to continue to exist.

The State Board shall consider the recommendation of the Secretary and any other information it deems appropriate. The State Board shall hold a public meeting within 60 days of receiving the recommendation of the Secretary at which it shall make its determination, and shall provide due notice of this meeting to the Secretary and all members of the union school district. Within 10 days of the meeting, the State Board shall notify the Secretary and all members of the union school district of its decision. If the State Board

1	approves the withdrawal, the State Board shall declare the membership of the
2	withdrawing member in the union school district terminated as of July 1
3	immediately following, or as soon after July 1 as the financial obligations of
4	the withdrawing member have been paid to, or an agreement has been made
5	with, the union school district in an amount to satisfy those obligations. The
5	State Board shall file the declaration with the Secretary of State, the clerk of
7	the withdrawing member, and the clerk of the union school district concerned
