13	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend the
14	settlement patterns criterion of Act 250 (10 V.S.A. chapter 151), known as
15	Criterion 9L. The bill proposes that, in lieu of demonstrating under Criterion
16	9L that a proposed project will not contribute to a pattern of strip development
17	or will be designed to minimize the characteristics of strip development, the
18	applicant may show that: (a) the legislative body and planning commission of
19	the municipality have issued written letters in support of the development or
20	subdivision; (b) an affirmative finding is warranted with respect to the Act 250
21	criterion that requires conformance with the duly adopted local plan; and
