Subject: Conservation and development; municipal government; hazardous waste

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to provide that a municipality or solid waste management district serving less than 1,000 households shall not be required to provide more than two events per year for the collection of nonregulated hazardous waste.

An act relating to hazardous waste collection

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
Sec. 1. 24 V.S.A. § $2202 \mathrm{a}(\mathrm{c})$ is amended to read:
(c)(1) No later than July 1, 1988, each municipality, as defined in subdivision 4303(12) of this title, shall join or participate in a solid waste management district organized pursuant to chapter 121 of this title no later than January 1, 1988, or participate in a regional planning commission's planning effort for purposes of solid waste implementation planning, as implementation planning is defined in 10 V.S.A. § 6602.

(4) A regional plan or a solid waste implementation plan shall include a component for the management of nonregulated hazardous wastes.

(E) For the purposes of this subsection (c), nonregulated hazardous wastes include hazardous wastes generated by households and exempt small quantity generators as defined in the hazardous waste management regulations adopted under 10 V.S.A. chapter 159.
(F) Under a regional plan or solid waste implementation plan, a
municipality or solid waste management district serving fewer than 1,000 households shall not be required to provide more than two events per year for the collection of nonregulated hazardous waste. Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE This act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
