2	all-terrain vehicle travel by the selectboard or trustees or local governing body
3	and is so posted by the municipality except an.
4	(C) The ATV is operated for a distance of one mile or less along a
5	State highway that either connects properties open to ATV travel, including a
6	town highway that has been opened to ATV travel, or provides access to the
7	closest food, fuel, lodging, or repair services available from property open to
8	ATV travel. However, this subdivision shall not permit operation along a
9	limited access facility unless authorized by the Traffic Committee. A person
10	operating an ATV along a State highway under this subdivision (b)(1)(C) shall:
11	(i) wear protective headgear of a type approved by the
12	Commissioner of Motor Vehicles;
13	(ii) maintain financial responsibility at the levels specified at
14	<u>23 V.S.A. § 800;</u>
15	(iii) comply with the signaling requirements of 23 V.S.A. §§ 1064
16	and 1065; and
17	(iv) comply with all motor vehicle laws applicable when an ATV
18	is operated on a public highway as specified at 23 V.S.A. § 3501(5).
19	(D) The all-terrain vehicle is being used for agricultural purposes
20	may be and is operated not closer than three feet from the traveled portion of
21	any highway for the purpose of traveling within the confines of the farm.

2	(11) On limited access highways, rights of way rights-of-way, or
3	approaches unless permitted by the Traffic Committee under section 1004 of
4	this title. In no cases shall the use of all-terrain vehicles be permitted on any
5	portion of the National System of Interstate and Defense Highways unless the
6	Traffic Committee permits operation on these highways.
