16	(b)(1) This section shall not apply to gross negligence, recklessness, or
17	intentional misconduct on the part of the agritourism provider.
18	(2) This section shall not apply if the harm to the participant is
19	proximately caused by a dangerous condition that:
20	(A) is not a risk inherent in the agritourism activity; and

1	(B) the agritourism provider knows or should know of the dangerous
2	condition and does not disclose it to the participant.
3	(c) As used in this section:
4	(1) "Agritourism activity" means an agriculturally related educational,
5	entertainment, historical, cultural, or recreational activity, including
6	pick-your-own operations and farm markets, that is conducted on a farm that
7	allows or invites members of the public to observe or participate in the activity,
8	whether or not a fee is charged.
9	(2) "Agritourism provider" means a person who owns, operates, or
10	sponsors an agritourism activity, or a person who is employed by or volunteers
11	for an agritourism provider.
12	(3) "Risk inherent in an agritourism activity" means a danger or
13	condition that is an integral part of an agritourism activity.
