Last session, the Burlington Charter Changes were put back on the wall. This was the proper way to handle them. Either that, or vote them down in committee.

Vermont has state gun law preemption -- the Sportsman's Bill of Rights -- so that the state doesn't end up with a patchwork of gun restrictions. In a small state like Vermont, where people pass through several towns as they travel, such balkinization would be disaterous.

Therefore, I respectfully ask you to vote NO on the three Burlington Charter Changes bills.
