

**No. R-9 (Special Session). House concurrent resolution congratulating Molly McCreedy of Calais on her achievements as a high school shot put athlete.**

Whereas, as a student at U-32 High School, Molly McCreedy developed a special athletic talent in throwing the shot put, and

Whereas, this past winter, she established a new State record while competing at the indoor State track and field championships held at the University of Vermont, and

Whereas, on June 2, 2018, Molly McCreedy set a new outdoor State girls' record of 45 feet, 11.25 inches at the State track and field championship meet conducted in South Burlington, breaking the prior outdoor mark that had stood for 19 years, and

Whereas, on June 9, 2018, her victory streak continued at the New England high school track and field championships, held at the University of New Hampshire, where she earned a first-place finish with a throw of 45 feet, 8.25 inches, measuring nearly four feet longer than that of her nearest competitor, and

Whereas, Molly McCreedy concluded her high school shot put odyssey as an entrant in the national high school track and field meet in Greensboro, North Carolina, and this fall, she will attend the University at Buffalo, now therefore be it
