1	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
2	Sec. 1. 32 V.S.A. § 6061(4) is amended to read:
3	(4) "Household income" means modified adjusted gross income, but not
4	less than zero, received in a calendar year by:
5	(A) all persons of a household while members of that household,
6	except for the first \$30,000.00 in income for a relative who has temporarily
7	moved into the household to care for a person 70 years of age or older; and
8	(B) the spouse of the claimant who is not a member of that household
9	and who is not legally separated from the claimant, unless the spouse is at least
10	62 years of age and has moved to a nursing home or other care facility with no
11	reasonable prospect of returning to the homestead.
12	(C) As used in subdivision (A) of this subdivision (4), the term
13	"relative" means the child, grandchild, niece, nephew, or sibling of the person
14	requiring care. In order to claim the exclusion in subdivision (A), the claimant
15	and the relative must each separately attest to the nature of the caregiving
