9	municipalities to form a rural economic development infrastructure district.				
10	A rural economic development infrastructure district is empowered to plan,				
11	finance, own, and operate infrastructure, including renewable energy,				
12	telecommunications, transportation, and other facilities for the purpose of				
13	increasing community resilience, sustainability, and economic viability.				
14	District formation is by affirmative vote of the legislative body of each				
15	member municipality. A district is governed by a board of trustees in				
16	proportion to the relative population of each member municipality. Districts				
17	may accept grants, incur debt, or raise capital; however, debt service for any				
18	project shall be payable only out of revenues or monies of the district, not from				
19	funds generated by a member's taxing or assessment power. A district does				
20	not have the power to levy, assess, apportion, or collect any tax upon property				
21	within the district, nor upon any of its members.
