7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to increase the
8	amount of the health care claims tax to support a Green Mountain Care Board-
9	maintained database of prescription drugs that are on most health insurance
10	plans' formularies and for which prior authorization is not required.
11 12	An act relating to establishing a database of prescription drugs for which prior authorization is not required
13	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
14	Sec. 1. 18 V.S.A. § 9410a is added to read:
15	<u>§ 9410a. PRESCRIPTION DRUG FORMULARY DATABASE</u>
16	(a) The Green Mountain Care Board shall establish and maintain a current
17	database of prescription drugs that are included on most of the health insurance
18	plans covering residents of this State and for which prior authorization is not
19	required. The Board shall make the database available to health care providers
20	to inform their decision making when prescribing drugs for their patients.

1	(b)(1) Health insurers and pharmacy benefit managers shall provide to the
2	Board at least monthly, or more frequently if so requested by the Board, a list
3	of the prescription drugs on their formularies for which prior authorization is
4	not required. The Board shall use this information to maintain the database
5	established pursuant to subsection (a) of this section and shall ensure that the
6	database reflects the most current information, to the greatest extent
7	practicable.
8	(2) The Board shall undertake appropriate measures to protect the
9	confidentiality of any information provided by health insurers and pharmacy
10	benefit managers that reasonably could be considered trade secrets, as defined
11	<u>in 1 V.S.A. § 317(c)(9).</u>
12	(c) The Board may adopt rules pursuant to 3 V.S.A. chapter 25 as needed
13	to carry out the provisions of this section.

15	§ 10402. HEALTH CARE CLAIMS TAX
16	(a) There is imposed on every health insurer an annual tax in an amount
17	equal to $0.8 \\ 0.82$ of one percent of all health insurance claims paid by the
18	health insurer for its Vermont members in the previous fiscal year ending on
19	June 30. The annual fee shall be paid to the Commissioner of Taxes in one
20	installment due <del>by</del> <u>on or before</u> January 1.

1	(b) Revenues paid and collected under this chapter shall be deposited <u>as</u>
2	follows:
3	(1) 0.8 of one percent of all health insurance claims into the State Health
4	Care Resources Fund established in 33 V.S.A. § 1901d; and
5	(2) 0.02 of one percent of all health insurance claims into the Green
6	Mountain Care Board Regulatory and Administrative Fund established in
7	18 V.S.A. § 9404(d) to support the Board's establishment and maintenance of
8	the prescription drug formulary database pursuant to 18 V.S.A. § 9410a.

10	Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATES
11	(a) Sec. 1 (formulary database) shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
12	(b) Sec. 2 (health care claims tax) shall take effect on July 1, 2018 and shall
13	apply beginning with the claims tax due on January 1, 2019.
14	(c) This section shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
