- 12 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
- 13 Sec. 1. ADVISORY COUNCIL ON BENZODIAZEPINE PRESCRIBING
- 14 (a) Creation. There is created the Advisory Council on Benzodiazepine
- 15 Prescribing Practices for the purpose of advising the Commissioner of Health
- 16 <u>on matters related to the appropriate prescribing of benzodiazepines and the</u>
- 17 prevention of benzodiazepine abuse, misuse, and diversion.
- 18 (b) Membership. The Advisory Council shall be composed of the
- 19 <u>following 15 members:</u>
- 20 (1) the Commissioner of Health or designee;

1	(2) the Deputy Commissioner of Health for Alcohol and Drug Abuse
2	Programs or designee;
3	(3) the Commissioner of Mental Health or designee;
4	(4) the Vermont Attorney General or designee;
5	(5) the Director of the Blueprint for Health or designee;
б	(6) the Medical Director of the Department of Vermont Health Access;
7	(7) the Chair of the Board of Medical Practice or designee, who shall be
8	<u>a clinician;</u>
9	(8) a representative of the Vermont Medical Society, who shall be a
10	psychiatrist;
11	(9) a representative of the Vermont Board of Pharmacy, who shall be a
12	pharmacist;
13	(10) a faculty member of the academic detailing program at the
14	University of Vermont's College of Medicine;
15	(11) a representative of Bi-State Primary Care Association, who shall be
16	a primary care clinician;
17	(12) a representative of the Vermont Ethics Network;
18	(13) a representative of health insurers, who shall be selected by the
19	three health insurers with the most covered lives in Vermont;

1	(14) a drug abuse counselor licensed pursuant to 26 V.S.A. chapter 62,
2	who shall be selected by the Deputy Commissioner of Health for Alcohol and
3	Drug Abuse Programs; and
4	(15) a representative of the Vermont Substance Abuse Treatment
5	Providers.
6	(c) Powers and duties. The Advisory Council shall provide advice to the
7	Commissioner concerning rules for:
8	(1) the appropriate use of benzodiazepines;
9	(2) the appropriate use of the Vermont Prescription Monitoring
10	System; and
11	(3) the prevention of benzodiazepine abuse, misuse, and diversion.
12	(d) Assistance. The Advisory Council shall have the administrative,
13	technical, and legal assistance of the Department of Health.
14	(e) Meetings.
15	(1) The Commissioner of Health or designee shall serve as chair and
16	shall call the first meeting of the Advisory Council to occur on or before
17	<u>September 1, 2018.</u>
18	(2) The Advisory Council shall cease to exist on January 1, 2020.
19	(f) Compensation and reimbursement. Members of the Advisory Council
20	who are not employees of the State of Vermont and who are not otherwise
21	compensated or reimbursed for their attendance shall be entitled to per diem

- 2 <u>These payments shall be made from monies appropriated to the Department of</u>
- 3 <u>Health.</u>
- 4 (g) The Commissioner of Health, after seeking the advice of the Advisory
- 5 <u>Council, may adopt rules pursuant to 3 V.S.A. chapter 25 regarding the</u>
- 6 <u>appropriate use of benzodiazepines; the appropriate use of the Vermont</u>
- 7 <u>Prescription Monitoring System; and the prevention of benzodiazepine abuse.</u>
- 8 <u>misuse, and diversion.</u>
- 9 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
- 10 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
