13	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

15	§ 2198. EXCEPTIONS; LICENSE NOT REQUIRED
16	(a) All plumbing and specialty work performed in Vermont shall be
17	performed by persons licensed under this chapter except that a license shall not
18	be required for <u>any of</u> the following types of work:
19	(1) Any plumbing and specialty work performed by an owner or the
20	owner's regular employees in the owner-occupied, freestanding single family

1	single-family dwelling or in outbuildings accessory to the owner-occupied,
2	single family single-family dwelling.
3	(2) Installations of plumbing systems in laboratories for experimental
4	purposes only.
5	(3) A person who regularly employs a maintenance person whose duties
6	include the maintenance of plumbing on the property of that person.
7	(4) Plumbing or specialty installations performed as part of a training
8	project of a vocational school or other educational institution. However, the
9	installation shall be inspected if the building is to be sold as a private dwelling
10	or public building.
11	(5) A person who performs miscellaneous jobs of manual labor on the
12	person's own property in the course of which plumbing repairs or alterations
13	are made.
14	(6) For the construction, repair, or maintenance of buildings used
15	exclusively for agricultural purposes and animal housing located on owner-
16	occupied farms.
17	(7) Work performed by employees of any public or private water
18	company, who in the main course of their employment install, maintain, or
19	repair water supply pipes, meters, or control valves.

1	(8) A person who performs miscellaneous jobs of manual labor, such as
2	digging trenches or carrying or moving equipment or appliances, in order to
3	assist a plumber.
4	(b) Plumbing installed or maintained by persons included in this section
5	shall conform to state State law.
