Whereas, the continued availability of milk in school cafeterias has been one of his important priorities, and

<u>Whereas</u>, serving as an invaluable liaison between dairy farmers and retail stores is a role that Gary Wheelock has recognized is a primary concern for the region's dairy farmers, and

Whereas, Gary Wheelock's wise counsel has extended beyond our region's borders as he is a major participant in the deliberations of the United Dairy Industry Association (UDIA), and

Whereas, after a fulfilling career advocating, educating, facilitating, and serving on behalf of Vermont's dairy farmers, Gary Wheelock is concluding his career at NEDFC-NEDPB and looks forward to spending more time with his wife, Karen, and

Whereas, both Agri-Mark and St. Albans Cooperative, the regional dairy farmers' cooperatives, and the UDIA have expressed formally their appreciation for Gary Wheelock's major contributions to the vitality and continuity of the nation's dairy commerce, now therefore be it
