The Vermont Municipal Clerks' and Treasurers' Association is supportive of "An act relating to regulating notaries public". We have heard some concerns from our members but we believe this is a positive step, particularly as it pertains to training.

The VMCTA would like to move forward with updating the land record statutes. Currently the statutes do not recognize the computerization processes that we employ. This bill will allow us to pursue electronic land records, as well as update the antiquated pieces of the recording statutes.

We appreciate that the bill includes the exemption of fees for Town Clerks to be notaries.
