Ex officio notaries include: Capitol police officers (2 V.S.A. § 70); Supreme Court, county clerks, Superior Court clerks, deputy Superior Court clerks, justices of the peace, and town clerks and their assistants (24 V.S.A. § 441); and a town clerk, a State Police officer, a municipal police officer, a fish and game warden, a sheriff or deputy sheriff, and a motor vehicle inspector (32 V.S.A. § 1403).

Pursuant to 32 V.S.A. § 1403 and the former relationship with the county and courts, county clerks are to issue certifications of notaries public to ex officio public employees at no charge.

Pursuant to 32 V.S.A. § 1436, "the county clerk shall collect a fee of \$ 30.00, of which \$ 15.00 shall accrue to the State and \$ 15.00 shall accrue to the county."

The bulk of the appointments (both regular appointments and ex-officio) in a new term are received in the 1st 4 months - i.e. in this latest term we had received more than 12,700 appointments in those 1st 4 months.
