7	station. A person transporting a vessel to or from a water will be presumed to
8	have not violated subsections (a), (b), and (d) of this section if, upon launching
9	a vessel and upon leaving a water, the vessel is decontaminated at an approved
10	aquatic nuisance inspection station. If staff of an approved aquatic nuisance
11	inspection station observe a violation of subsection (a), (b), or (d) of this
12	section, staff shall notify the person transporting the vessel. If the person
13	transporting the vessel does not correct the violation before launching the
14	vessel or transporting away from the water, the staff of the approved aquatic
15	nuisance inspection station may report the violation to an appropriate law
16	enforcement entity.
