9 Town clerks shall receive the following fees for issuing marriage licenses
10 and vital event certificates:

11 (1) For issuing and recording a civil marriage license, ~~\$80.00~~ \$60.00 to
12 be paid by the applicant, ~~\$15.00~~ \$10.00 of which sum shall be retained by the
13 town clerk as a fee, ~~\$50.00~~ \$35.00 of which shall be deposited in the Domestic
14 and Sexual Violence Special Fund created by 13 V.S.A. § 5360, and \$15.00 of
15 which sum shall be paid by the town clerk to the State Treasurer in a return
16 filed quarterly upon forms furnished by the State Treasurer and specifying all
17 fees received by the town clerk during the quarter. Such quarterly period shall
18 be as of the first day of January, April, July, and October.
