Joint Senate Resolution Adopted on the Part of the Senate

J.R.S. 53.

Joint Senate resolution of the following title was offered, read and adopted on the part of the Senate, and is as follows:

By Senator Baruth,

J.R.S. 53. Joint resolution relating to weekend adjournment on April 19, 2024.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives:

That when the two Houses adjourn on Friday, April 19, 2024, it be to meet again no later than Tuesday, April 23, 2024.
