

STATE OF VERMONT Attorneys General

The office of Attorney General was established by act passed October 28, 1790; that act was repealed by an act passed November 10, 1797 (no Attorney General was chosen in 1795 or 1796 because of controversy surrounding continuance of the office). The office was re-established by 1904, Act No. 57.
