Qualifications:

Associate's or bachelor's degree in a law enforcement related field, plus 5-8 years of relevant law enforcement experience, or a combination of education and experience from which the following comparable knowledge and skills are acquired:

- Broad and in-depth knowledge and skills relevant to municipal law enforcement, including good understanding of principles and techniques, and in-depth knowledge of relevant laws, regulations, ordinances, and operating policies and procedures, with a strong background in criminal law and investigations, as well as good knowledge of civil liability issues.
- Excellent planning, organizational, administrative, personnel, and budget management skills, with considerable previous administrative experience.
- Experience with a full range of police department operations.
- Ability to deal effectively with a broad range of individuals, often in emergency, dangerous, and/or highly sensitive situations; ability to work cooperatively with and represent the Department to other law enforcement agencies, as well as State House officials and personnel.
- A valid Vermont motor vehicle Operator's License
- Security Training Skills
- Incident Command System training
- Communication with excellent people skills required.
- Preferred residency within 25 miles of the Vermont State House
