Subject: Corrections; technical corrections

Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to clarify that reports from the offender work programs board are to be made to the joint fiscal committee, not the joint fiscal office; and to repeal sections of law that are no longer relevant.

AN ACT RELATING TO TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO THE  
PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS AND CORRECTIONS STATUTES

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 28 V.S.A. § 761(a)(3) and (b)(2) are amended to read:

(3) The board shall report on its activities at the request of the commissioner, and at least annually to the commissioner and to the joint fiscal ~~office~~ committee.

(2) forward annually by January 1 to the joint fiscal ~~office~~ committee a maximum level of offender work program activity in each market segment during the term of the plan; and

Sec. 2. REPEAL

The following are repealed:

- 1           (1) 28 V.S.A. § 752(f), relating to reports of the joint fiscal office in  
2           years 2001, 2002, and 2003.
- 3           (2) 28 V.S.A. chapter 15, subchapter 2. Weeks School.
