Subject: Executive; state employees; positions

Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to prohibit: (1) the elimination of state employee positions, the firing or laying-off of state employees, or other reductions in force unless they would result in a net cost reduction to the state budget; and (2) any federally funded state employee position from being eliminated unless the service being provided by that employee is no longer needed by any resident of the state.
