Subject: Health; restaurants; health inspections

Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to require restaurants to post the
results of health inspections in a public location.

An act relating to restaurant health inspections

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 18 V.S.A. § 4306 is amended to read:

§ 4306. INSPECTION

(a) It shall be the duty of the board to enforce the provisions of this
subchapter and of 6 V.S.A. § 3312(d), and it shall be permitted to inspect
through its duly authorized officers, inspectors, agents, or assistants, at all
reasonable times, an establishment subject to the provisions of this subchapter.

The results of any such inspection shall be posted in public view on the
premises of the establishment.

(b) An establishment that is dissatisfied with its inspection results may
request a reinspection at any time within 60 calendar days following the initial

- 1 inspection. The commissioner of health shall determine by rule the fee to be
- 2 assessed for such reinspection, which shall be borne by the establishment.
